The institute is an autonomous organization registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860. It is managed by a Board of Governors. Director is the Executive Head of the Institute.

5.	The eligibility of applicants in respect of age, qualifications, experience will be determined with reference to the last date of receipt of applications.
6.	Candidates have to apply online ONLY. Candidate should take a printout of the filled application and keep it for record.

7.	Number of posts as mentioned in advertisement may be increased or decreased depending on the institute requirements.
8.	Director, NITTTTR, Chandigarh reserves the right to either fill up all the posts or some of the posts or none of them without assigning any reason.
9.	Director, NITTTTR Chandigarh reserves the right to cancel the whole process without assigning or clarifying any reason.

11.	Candidate should upload scanned copies of the following: 1. Proof of age. 2. Educational Qualification (details marks sheets and Degree/Diploma) 3. Copies of Experience Certificate(s) 4. Certificate of reservation claim, if any. 5. Photograph 6. NOC from current employer/organisation.
12.	There is no need to submit any certificate in original along with the application. The Institute does not take responsibility for returning any certificate. You will be required to bring your original certificates, in case, you are called for interview/document verification.
13.	A candidate, found to have furnished any particulars which are false or suppressed information, will be disqualified, and if appointed will be liable to dismissal.

Selection Process:

14. The selection process (screening & selection) will be as follows:
a) **For Research Assistant, Electronics Engineer, Producer and Senior Visualizer :**
i) Written test followed by trade test and interview.
ii) Only first (Top) 15 candidates for each post in merit prepared on the basis of written test, (weightage 40%), qualification (weightage 30%) and experience (weightage 10%) marks will be called for document verification and trade test. (15 candidates for one post). The details are given below :-

Weightage to Qualification and Experience for Screening for Document Verification/ Trade Test is as under:

- iii) Weightage to the various components of the written test for the post of Research Assistant, Electronics Engineer, Producer and Senior Visualizer is as under:

Post specific	60%
Mental ability, Reasoning and Mathematical skills	10%
Computer awareness	20%
English Language Proficiency	10%

- iv) Trade test will be of qualifying nature and will not carry marks
v) If a candidate fails to qualify the trade test, he/she will not be called for personal interview and will not be considered for Merit List.
vi) The candidates who will qualifying in the Trade Test will be given an opportunity for the personal interview.
vii) The final Selection Merit list will be prepared based on the score awarded basis on the criteria at (ii) above plus the marks awarded in the **personal interview** (20% weightage).

b) For Visualizer/Graphic Artist

- i) Written Test followed by trade test.
- ii) Only first (Top) 15 candidates for each post in merit prepared on the basis of written test will be called for document verification and trade test. (15 for one post).
- iii) Weightage to the various components of the written test for the post of Visualizer/Graphic Artist is as under:

Post specific including computer knowledge	80%
Mental ability, Reasoning and Mathematical skills and English Language Proficiency	20%

- iv) Trade test will be of qualifying in nature and will not carry marks
- v) If a candidate fails to qualify the trade test, his/her name will be removed from the merit list.
- vi) Final Merit List will be based on written test score out of the qualified candidates in trade test.

- 15. All the applicants, irrespective of the fulfilment of qualification and experience, will be allowed to take the written test. It is in the interest of the candidates that they should satisfy themselves regarding the eligibility requirements before applying for any of the posts and appearing for written test.
- 16. All the applicants will be required to appear for written test to be conducted for each category of posts.
- 17. Only candidates who qualify the written test and are placed in the merit will be called for interview/document verification.
- 18. Any candidate who fails to appear for the written test, interview/document verification, if called upon by the Institute to do so, will not be considered for appointment and no further correspondence shall be entertained.
- 19. Successful candidates will be informed the results of his/her test/interview/document verification in due course and interim enquiries about the result will not be entertained.
- 20. The Institute reserves the right to call only such persons for interview/document verification as the Director or any other authority appointed by the Institute may deem fit. It is not obligatory on the part of the institute to call for interview/document verification every candidate possessing minimum qualifications and experience.
- 21. No correspondence will be entertained from the applicant either before or after the selection. The decision of the institute would be final.
- 22. Canvassing in any form will disqualify the applicant.
- 23. The proof of education, qualification, age, experience and reservation claimed etc. will be verified at the time of interview/document verification.
- 24. The written test for all the posts will comprise following components:
 - (i) The written test for all the posts will be MCQ (Multiple Choice Questions) type, where the candidate will have to mark the correct (most relevant) choice out of the given choices.
 - (ii) There will be 100 questions in each test.
 - (iii) Total duration of the test will be 2 hours.
 - (iv) There will be separate question papers for each of the posts i.e. Research Assistant, Electronics Engineering, Producer and Senior Visualizer.
